NDIS legislation

New NDIS legislation has just been passed by the Australian Parliament. Once there is more information, we will share what this means for your child and family.

One of the proposed changes is a list of supports which NDIS funding can be used for. We have provided feedback to the government on the draft list, and we want to make sure that NDIS reflects the following principles:

- The need to support age-appropriate independence during childhood
- The importance of short breaks and respite for families
- The central role of education in the lives of children



If you're the parent of a child with developmental delay or disability aged 0-12 and have experienced early childhood intervention, we'd love to hear from you.

ACD is hosting consultations as part of the review of best practice early intervention led by the University of Melbourne, funded by the Australian Government.
