Save money this Christmas with the Carer Card

With costs adding up around the festive season, make sure you take advantage of a Carer Card!

Victorian Carer Card holders get discounts on shopping, public transport, and leisure activities. This includes:

- 5% off selected gift cards
- 10% off at Booktopia
- 20% off at Salvos stores
- · 4c fuel discounts
- public transport concessions

If you don't already have one, the Carer Card, also called the "we care" card, is simple to apply for. You're eligible if you receive the Carer Payment or the Carer Allowance. Even if you don't get these payments, your GP can fill in the form and confirm that you are a carer.

Victorian School Saving Bonus

The School Saving Bonus is \$400 to help families cover the costs of uniforms, textbooks, and other school costs. All students at Victorian Government schools are eligible, including those starting Prep in 2025. Students at non-government school who receive the Camps, Sports and Excursions Fund are also eligible.
